

# | Sizwe Khoza

Born two years before the end of the civil war in Mozambique (his home country) Sizwe moved to South Africa in 1995. During his final year at school, he attended Saturday classes and ultimately graduated from Artist Proof Studio.

Sizwe really enjoyed working on this project - although he found it a bit challenging, as he is used to printing lino in black and white and sometimes working in multiple colours. This time he had to use purple and follow a brief whilst trying to get it right, which made the process even more rewarding. He used linocut, a surfaced printing process which requires one to carve out and focus on the negatives, using hand colouring. His piece is titled "Ukukhamba ukubona", referring to his journey of learning through the process of looking back in order to move forward, which connects with our brief.

He started as a student, then instructor and is now part of Artist Proof Studio's alumni. Hoping for many more exciting times together, he's enjoyed the many projects they've worked on together.
